



## *Auxiliary Chaplain of the Year Award Nomination*

**Purpose:** To Honor Auxiliary and District Chaplains for their commitment and service to our veterans, Post and Auxiliary members, and families.

The following are the criteria for Chaplain of the Year Award:

- Must be serving or have served as either Aux. or District Chaplain.
- Be recognized for a positive impact on people in the community, and for contributing to furthering the goals of the Auxiliary.
- Focus shall be on ministering to veterans and their families.

**Nominations can be made by any Auxiliary or District Officer.**

### **Details:**

- Nominations must be submitted to the Auxiliary Dept. Chaplain no later than March 31<sup>st</sup>.
- The written nomination should be no more than 2 pages
- Include a list of accomplishments and/or community events participated in (ex. Volunteering for community, hospital visits, nursing home visits, #cards sent, #phone calls, etc.)
- Tell why you feel the Chaplain should be honored. Include the nominee's phone number.
- Department judges will be 1 Past Department President, 1 District Chaplain or President, and 1 additional member.
- The Chaplain selected by the judges will be notified by the State Chaplain and announced at the State Convention Awards Banquet.
