- 1. Faith, act in good faith in the interest of our organization, not what is good for you.
- 2. Loyalty, act with undivided loyalty to our organization, avoid conflict of interest, avoid perception of impropriety.
- 3. Obedience, faithful to founding documents, adhere to our mission, obey the law,
- *Once a new member is voted on, she is a member. No one has the right to question the eligibility except the auxiliary. Section 108.
- *No member can be deprived of rights, if they pay their dues. Section 110.
- *All auxiliaries are to give a copy of their first audit to the Post as their financial report.

~~~KNOW THE 5 SIGNS; YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE! ~~~

- *CHANGE DIRECTION: Know the 5 signs of mental illness;
 - *Personality changes, uncharacteristically angry, anxious, agitated, or moody. Withdrawal or isolation from other people,
 - *May neglect self-care and engage in risky behavior, overcome with hopelessness and overwhelmed by circumstances.
- *GIVE AN HOUR: You connect, you reach out, you inspire hope and you offer help. Show compassion and caring and a willingness to find a solution when the person may not have the will or drive to do it alone. There are many resources in our communities. If everyone is more open and honest about our emotional health and well-being, we can prevent pain and suffering, and those in need will get the help they deserve. Did you know that National Home also helps our Veterans find help? Use their hotline and have the veteran call.
- *WOMEN VETERANS CAMPAIGN: The Department of Veterans Affairs partnered with *Lean in Women Veterans* to launch the campaign, "I Serve" in efforts to highlight women veterans who have answered the call to duty. The campaign aspires to promote the diversity of women veterans and celebrate the many accomplishments they have had in our military. To participate, female veterans are asked to record a 15 second video on their phones reading a specific script ---"I am... and this is what a veteran looks like..." (Pause)" I serve/served!"
