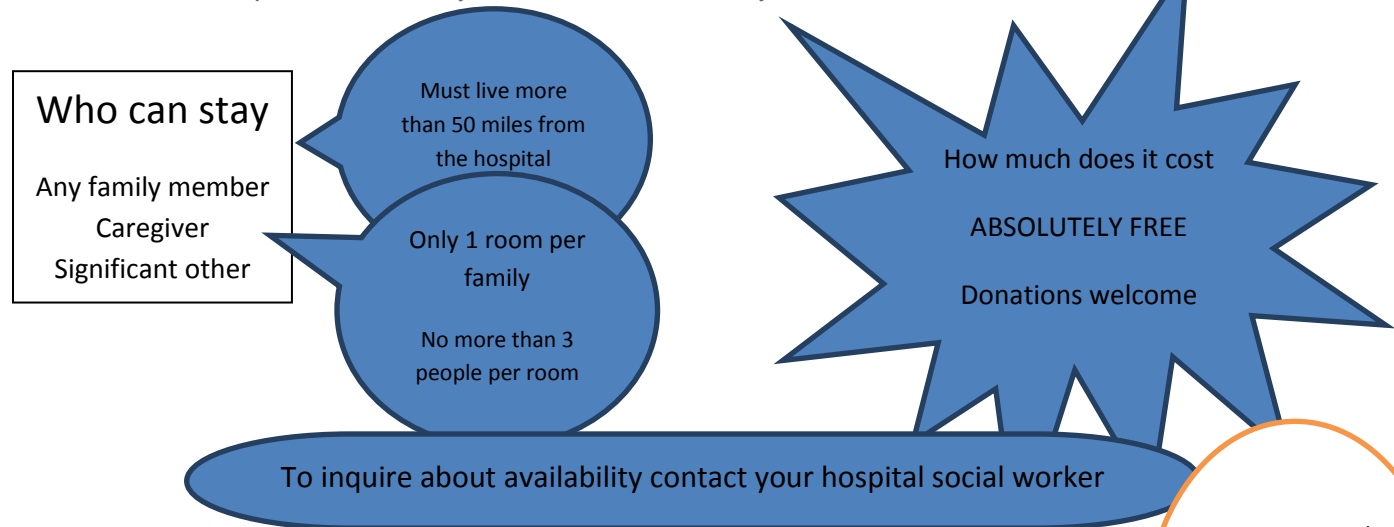




Since opening on September 10, 2008, the **VA Puget Sound Fisher House** has been privileged to serve over **3,000** families of Veterans and active duty military personnel.
